1. West Valley Clean Water Presentation

- a. A couple representatives from the West Valley Clean Water Authority gave a presentation on stormwater pollution and how it affects Campbell. They would like to collaborate on a project that focuses on educating and/or improving watershed quality in the city. Some ideas for projects included a social media ad competition, creek clean ups, and school assessments. The commissioners agreed to discuss the project further and keep in touch with the West Valley Clean Water Authority members.
