 - g. Social Justice is holding a women's march poster making event this week. Some ideas for future events included working with environment to inform people on environmental justice.
 - h. Recreation received some ideas for events including game nights with other teens, pen pals, drive in movies, and a chalk art competition.

- a. Commissioners briefly talked about what improvements could be made. This included having the Campbell library share their events on Facebook and making a constant contact email list to share events with.
