Notice is hereby given that the Historic Preservation Board of the City of Campbell has set the time of **5:00 p.m.**, or shortly thereafter, on Wednesday, **October 25, 2017**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California, for a Public Hearing to consider changes to the Historic Preservation Ordinance; Chapter 21.33 of the City of Campbell's Municipal Code.

You are receiving this notice as the owner of a home that is either officially listed as a Historic Resource on the *Historic Resource Inventory* or a home that is listed on the City's *Eligible Resource List*. The draft ordinance is subject to change following each of those meetings.
